# Academic Calendar for Korean Language Programs

### Program Overview

The Korean language course is operated according to the needs and levels of learners. The basic aim of Korean language classes is communication-oriented, and excellent faculty members provide the best Korean language education with the aim of integrated development of students' grammar, speaking, listening, reading, and writing. We run a Korean Language Helper system where students can practice conversation and exchange culture with Kyung Hee University students.

The Korean language course is divided into Regular Course (10 weeks) and an Intensive course (3 weeks). The regular course is operated in six stages: beginner (I-II), intermediate (I-II), advanced (I-II), and Korean studies (graduate level) preparation. The short-term course (3-week intensive course) is open in spring (March) and summer (August and September).

### Regular course 10 weeks/200 hours

- 10 weeks per semester, 4 semesters per year
- Provide a systematic and intimate communication-oriented classroom environment
- Drama, K-POP, practical Korean, pronunciation, etc. classes
- Conducts useful and fun hands-on cultural classes such as Taekwondo, K-Beauty, Danso, and barista
- Conducts various field trips to experience Korean history and culture
- Club activities to interact with students from other countries

### Intensive course 3 weeks/60 hours

- Three times a year in March, August, and September for three weeks
- Provides an intensive communication-oriented classroom environment
- Conducts cultural classes such as K-POP, dramas, traditional games, and calligraphy
- Experience Korean traditional culture and modern culture through field trips (2 times)

### Special Course

- Operation of special courses tailored to consignment agencies

# Admission Guide for the Institute of International Education

### How to Apply

- Submit the application form and the documents by post, or in person



### Subject

- Foreigners or overseas Koreans who are over 18 years old

### Documents Submission (Visa waiver only)

- Application form (Inquiries and submission via Email), One ID photo, Copy of a passport, Apostille diploma
- Application form (Online submission)
- Copy of a passport, Apostilled diploma, bank certificate (submit via post of in person)

※ The documents will not be returned once submitted.

※ The documents that has to be submitted differs by country, so please make an inquiry via email and get a specific guideline.

### Tuition Fee (From September, 2023)

Tuition fee (including applicaion fee, 90,000KRW)

Regular course - 10 weeks ₩1,890,000

Intensive course- 3 weeks ₩990,000

### How to make a payment

- After the document screening, the invoice will be sent

※ The payment must be in the student's name.

### Insurance

- Students for the regular course and intensive course will be join to the group insurance by the IIE.
- If you stay more than 6 months in Korea, you will automatically join into National Health Insurance of Korea.

### Refund policy

- In case of canceling the admission, the tuition will be get refund by Lifelong Education Act.
- The refund is only possible with the tuition. Please find the details from the website about the refund policy.

### Issuance of Certificate of Admission

- The certificate of admission will be only issued to the student who applied for more than two semesters, and who paid the tuition fee.
- The certificate of admission will be not issued to the students who applied for only one semester of for the intensive course.
- The certificate of admission cannot be used other than issuing the visa.

### Visa

- The student need to get a detailed and accurate guide from the embassy, since the documents and the visa type are different by country to country.

### Scholarship

- Kyung Hee University's Institute of International Education operates a scholarship system to encourage students to actively learn and participate in classes, and to ease the financial burden.
- The first and second places in each class are selected through a scholarship committee by comprehensively evaluating the attitudes and grades of the class

### Application for Students ID Card

Kyung Hee University's student ID is issued to students at IIE. Using your student ID, you can use the Central Library and various school facilities just like Kyung Hee University students.

Korean language helpers (dowoomi)

There is a volunteer program where Kyung Hee University students help foreign students at IIE with studying Korean and adapting to life in Korea. We are always looking for Korean language helpers, and you can meet Korean helpers to practice Korean, learn Korean culture, or engage in language exchange activities.

### Field Trips

You can feel and experience the Korean culture and natural environment learned in the classroom through field trips (Seoul Tower, Gyeongbokgung, Nami Island, enjoying performances, pottery making, etc.) once every semester.

### Dormitory

The Institute of International Education operates off-campus dormitories for foreign students. Since the dormitory is near Hoegi Station, it is easy to use convenient facilities and move around Seoul city. You can choose a single room (Richville, Chang Deok Ahn) or a double room (Chang Deok Ahn), and the dormitory room is equipped with wired and wireless internet, a washing machine, a refrigerator, an air conditioner, a desk, and a closet. We also provide external dormitories provided by international education center collaboration institutions. There is a 24-hour management staff on site, and security is maintained through electronic locks. More information about dormitories can be found on the website of IIE.


